# A Message from the **Executive Director**



Dear Friends and Partners,

On behalf of Uchembere Wabwino I present to you the annual report for 2022. During this year we have had major milestones, in terms of client's impact and growth as an organization. In 2022 we served 1794 people who came for sexual reproductive health services at our clinic, we gave immunizations to 3600 under five children and introduced a program for sexual reproductive health education and information in 15 secondary schools. We also managed to introduce a new service, laboratory which will be used for diagnostic laboratory test such as Full blood count, Grouping and cross matching, biochemistry analysis and electrolyte analysis. We also managed to purchase some of medical equipment for theatre such as theater bed, anesthesia machine, electrocardiogram machine to help us during emergencies such as the need for caesarean section when labour is failing to progress in order to save the life of the mother and that of the new born.

We introduced 4 outreach clinics to the remote areas of Mzimba to increase access to sexual reproductive health in collaboration with Mzimba north DHO. These are existing outreach clinics under Mzimba north DHO and we work with them to increase access to sexual reproductive health services.

Our outreach clinics have helped us to create memorable stories for women to have access to advanced maternal care such as Ultrasound scanning services within their reach and prompt referral to higher facility whenever there is a need.

I am very grateful for the support and team work that we currently have. Without your efforts the clinic would not have been where it is as of today.



We conducted a survey and found that most adolescents are getting unwanted pregnancies and sexually transmitted infections. Disseminated information about sexual reproductive health to 1000 received information, 500 accessed sexual reproductive health services like HIV testing and counseling, Family planning methods, treatment of STI'S.



#### **THEATER**

We plan to introduce theatre which will be used to conduct minor surgeries for caesarean example section, total abdominal hysterectomy and tubal ligation. We have been having challenges when a pregnant laboring woman has prolonged labor or when her labor has failed to progress. Normally, we rush with a patient to a higher facility which takes some minutes to reach the destination depending on traffic in the road and this has been very challenging because we want to provide a safe space for women to deliver. So, the introduction of the theatre will ease the burden and will increase trust from our clients that if things will not go well in a normal process, surgery will be conducted in order to save a life, because we believe that every life matters.


We received a grant from Growth Accelerator Malawi for the laboratory which is restricted funding.

Mwayi is a 16-year-old girl who came to our clinic to seek for antenatal care. She had an early pregnancy. It was unplanned and un intended pregnancy, and using our Ultrasound scan we diagnosed her with having a set of twins. She went through the whole process antenatal care and she delivered the normally without twins any complication. Now Mwayi and the twins are doing fine, we regularly check on them and she is continuing her education. with When she finishes her education, she says she wants to be a nurse so that she should also help other people.
